RE: EXTENSION AND UPGRADING OF EXISTING TOURIST FACILITIES AT ANUHA ISLAND RESORT.

This office has awared that my letter to you of 31st October 1987, which had asked you to suspend all extensions and upgrading developments on Anuha whilst the landowners are disputing your rights to carryout such developments, has been totally neglected by you and your Company.

The matter has been discussed during the very reflect Central Previncial Executive dated 30/11 - 4/12/87, and it has some concerns such as:-

- (a) that such Company personnells who do not have any respect for resource owners and the laws of the country will certainly have no more rooms to invest now and the future in Central Province.
- (b) that the bad attitudes of such Company personnells will affect the very loyal, honest and the trustworthy Companies wishing to invest in the Central Province in the future.

With the foregoing the Provincial Executive has concluded that no further developments must be done on the Anuha Tourist Resort until the proposed High Court case is over.
