

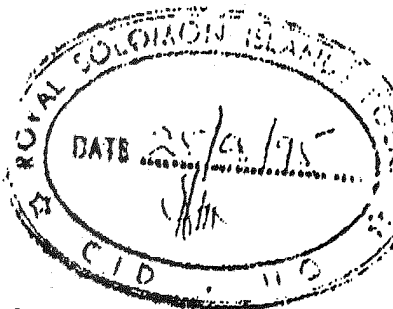

1. Following your complaint lodged over the lease of Anuha and further reference to my memo to DPP Ref.CID/4 OF 02/08/95, the following is the latest advise from the office of Director of Public Prosecution.
2. There is likely a criminal offence committed but the question of whether the Power of Attorney is still valid or not must first be cleared in the high court.
3. Therefore, you are advised to get a declaration from the court for the validity of the Power of Attorney.
